Therapeutic Strategies in Advanced Parkinson's Disease With Focus on Infusion therapies

The medical management of moderate/intermediate and advanced stages of Parkinson's disease (PD) is complex.

In contrast to other etiologies for Parkinsonism, PD patients typically have asymmetric motor symptoms and Levodopa responsiveness. As the disease progresses the effect of Levodopa starts to wear off. Motor fluctuations occur, characterized by the „end of dose“ phenomenon or “wearing-off” where patients have to diminish the interval between in-take of oral medication. These problems are often addressed with levodopa adjustments and the addition of adjunctive medication. As such it becomes ever more challenging to achieve a satisfying treatment that successfully counteracts the symptoms of advanced PD while at the same time minimizing side effects. Motor fluctuations impair quality of life and cause significant disability.

In this symposium, together with international experts, we will approach current concepts and strategies in advanced Parkinson's disease.
